

REGION REPRESENTATIVES JOB DESCRIPTION

*Promote the association at all appropriate opportunities (i.e. all-conference, rules & mechanics meetings, district seed meetings, etc.)

*Attend MBCA Board meetings (at least one per year of which there are four...the evening and morning of the MBCA Coaches Clinic in the fall and the Saturday morning of the Final Four for both weekends---Class 4 & 5 and Class 1, 2 & 3).

*Be the chief liason for the MBCA All-State selection committee from your district. This task includes the following:

- 1) Contact and name coaches from each class to represent your district in this process by December 1.
- 2) Provide names and e-mail addresses for each of these coaches to Bill Gunn (mosportsstaff@yahoo.com) so they can be placed on the MBCA web-site (mobca.org) for all coaches around the state to know who is representing them.
- 3) Area coaches will submit nominations of worthy players by class in their area and send them all to the district representative by March 1 using a form provided by the MBCA through its newsletter and web-site.
- 4) District representatives will forward all nominations to Bill Gunn by March 5.
- 5) A master-list of all nominated all-state players from around the state will be e-mailed back to the district representatives by March 9 so that they may be reviewed prior to the selection committee meetings in Columbia. This master list will also be forwarded to Gary Filbert in Columbia to have on hand for those meetings.
- 6) The aforementioned coaches designated to select the All-State team will attend selection committee meetings in Columbia during their respective Final Four weekends.
